and trim the sail.*

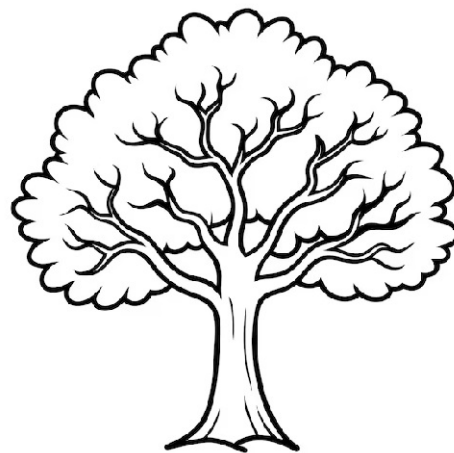
*When the Wind blows from the East, expect the

Dedication Ritual

- 2. Light the candle.*
- 3. Say a personal prayer or invocation.*
- 4. Touch the book with each element and declare your intent to use it wisely.*

Basic Altar Setup

Here is a simple description of a typical Wiccan altar layout:

- Center: Pentacle or representation of Spirit
- Left side (Goddess side): Chalice, Moon symbols, Water bowl, white candle
- Right side (God side): Athame or Wand, Sun symbols, Incense, red candle
- Top center Offering bowl or seasonal decorations
- Bottom center Book of Shadows or ritual script

Magical Tools and Their Uses

Athame – Ritual knife used to direct energy and cast circles. Associated with Fire or Air.

Wand – Tool for channeling and directing energy. Associated with Air or Fire.

Chalice – Represents the element of Water and the womb. Used for offerings and blessings.

Pentacle – A flat disc inscribed with a pentagram, representing Earth and grounding energy.

Cauldron – Symbol of transformation and rebirth. Used for burning herbs, mixing potions.

Bell – Used to clear space and mark ritual transitions. Associated with Air.

Boline – White-handled knife used for cutting herbs and physical items (not energy).

Censer – Holds incense for purification and invocation. Represents Air.

Crystal – Amplifies or channels specific types of magical energy.

Book of Shadows – Sacred text for recording rituals, spells, and spiritual growth.
